Entry Fees for USMGA/CMGA members:

\$50.00 per division-fees must be RECEIVED by February 14, 2012

\$70.00 per division-fees received on or after February 15th.
No exceptions.

For Non-Members:

\$20.00 additional fee for non-members per division.

New Refund Policy: Full refunds will be given up until the entry closing date. The entry closing date for this event is Tuesday, February 14, 2012. Refund requests made after the closing date will be given minus \$20.00 per entry.

Stabling:

\$50.00 for the weekend. Indoor stalls with rubber mats. Includes three bags of shavings.

Additional shavings are \$5.00 per bag. Limited paddock availability. Contact Grace for more information.

Divisions:

Norman Patrick: This division is open for games riders of any age.

Under 17: This division is open to any games rider under the age of 17.

Open: This division is open to any games rider that is age 14 or older and confident with games at speed.

General Notes:

Arena: Warm up will be in the outdoor arena at the Jaeckle Centre. The games competition will take place in the indoor arena.

Games to be played: Any game listed in the USMGA rulebook may be played.

Equipment Setup Volunteers: Teams must provide volunteers to set equipment for their own team! Volunteers must be at least 14 years old. If your team has only four riders, you must have a volunteer (14 years of age or older) standing by **with a riding helmet** to hold letters for the pony express game. If you have a fifth rider, that team member can hold the letters for your team.

Referees: Each team must provide one assistant referee for the heat after theirs. Your team volunteer must check in with the scorekeeper just prior to the session they are going to referee.

Riding in multiple divisions: Riders may ride in more than one division. Horses may be ridden in two divisions. Chief referee reserves the right to remove a horse from competition if he determines that it is unfit for play in a second division.

Tack/bit/jewelry check: Riders will be subject to a tack, bit and jewelry check prior to each session. If you have questions or concerns, email Liz at pgreili@bellsouth.net before arriving for the competition.

Required Documents: Please mail a copy of your horse's current negative coggins with your entry or present it **prior to unloading** your horse at the Jaeckle Centre.

Children: Children under the age of 14 will not be allowed in the arena of play.

Dogs: Dogs are **not** allowed at the Jaeckle Centre.

Cameras: Cameras are not allowed in the arena of play. Only one USMGA photographer will be allowed in the arena. All other photographers, please take pictures from the viewing stands.
