The Fun Not in the Sun II competition at the Frankfort Lakeside Arena is sponsored by the United States Mounted Games Association (USMGA). **There will be a 17 & Under / 4-Ever Young combined division, an Open division and a Training division.** Riders may enter as a team or enter as individuals to be scrambled. Depending on the number of entries, the organizers have the right to form scramble teams. For updates on the competition, or to form your own scramble team, use USMGA@yahoogroups.com. LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ON A SPACE AVAILABLE BASIS.

Divisions:

- **Forever-Young:** This division is open to adults and to moms, dads, family teams, and former USPC and USMGA riders who want to get back into playing mounted games.
- **17 and Under:** This division is open to riders age 17 and under who are not ready for the Open division. Rules will be gone over before each race.
- **Open:** This division is open to any games rider that is age 14 and older and confident with games at speed.
- **Training:** This division is open to riders of any age learning the games or training green ponies for the games. There are no vaulting games in this division and riders may receive assistance. Training division rides for the same amount of time as the other divisions and will ride as many races as that time allows. Experienced riders will be available to coach teams in this division.

Teams will play two ground sessions each day.

*Riders may ride in more than one division. If Open is your primary division you will then be considered hors-concourse or no contest in the additional division.

*This is a weekend team/pairs competition. Riders who do not have a team and can attend both days will be placed onto teams first. There is no discount on the price if you can only attend one day. If you have worked out with your team to share the weekend, please note this on the entry. If you have a team which is aware that you will only ride one day this is not a problem.



Entry Fees:

\$40 per division for USMGA/CMGA members.

\$15 for Open /Forever /17&Under Clinic with Clive Jones (No additional charge for Training Division Riders)

\$15 additional fee for non-members.

\$20 fee for late entries (postmarked after August 9th 2010).

You may sign up to be a USMGA member at the competition. **Membership fees are: \$25 for individuals and \$40 for families.** Spectators for all competitions are welcome free of charge.

Games to be played:

Games will be selected from the following list for the clinic and the competitions: agility aces, association race, ball and cone, bottle shuttle, carton, hi-lo, hug-a-mug, hula-hoop, litter lifters, mug shuffle, pony pairs, run and ride, sock, speed weavers, sword, three-legged sack, three flag, three mug, tool box scramble and two flag. Venue Information

Stabling/Haul-in Fee: There is a \$25/day stall charge during the competition, which includes 1 bale of shavings and use of a tack stall shared with your teammates. Use of a stall, for any length of time, incurs the daily stall charge. Ponies cannot be tied up in the stall aisle. You are welcome to show out of your trailer however, **Lakeside has recently imposed a \$15/day haul-in fee for ponies are not using stalls.**

Food/Water: Lunch will be available for an additional \$5/day. Water is available on the grounds. There are plenty of grocery stores and restaurants within 3 miles of Lakeside Arena.

Directions: Lakeside Arena is located-in Frankfort, KY. Off I-64 exit #58 turn south on highway 60 (Versailles Rd), then take first right onto state hwy 1681(Duncan Rd), go approx. 1.5 miles and entrance to Lakeside will be on the left.

Accommodations:

Camping: Fifty campsites and hookups are available at Lakeside Arena @ \$20.00/night. Restrooms and showers are available for campers. Hookups include electricity.

Please return this form with your entry.

The undersigned acknowledges the inherent risk involved in riding and working around horses, which risks include bodily injury from using, riding or being in close proximity to horses among other risks, and further that both horse and rider can be injured in normal use or in competition and schooling.

In consideration for the privilege of riding and working around horses at **Lakeside Arena** the undersigned does hereby agree to hold harmless and indemnify **Lakeside Arena, US Mounted Games Association**, its officers, sponsors and members and further release them from any liability or responsibility for accident, damage, injury or illness to Undersigned or any horse owned by me or to any family member or spectator accompanying the Undersigned on the premises of **Lakeside Arena**.

I fully understand that riding and the playing of mounted games are very dangerous activities. I fully understand that riding is a very dangerous activity with many inherent risks including (i) The propensity of an equine to behave in dangerous ways which may result in injury to the rider, trainer, groom or handler, (ii) The inability to predict an equine's reaction to sound, movements, objects, persons or animals. I wish to participate in these activities knowing they are dangerous. I accept and assume all the risks of injury (including death) to myself or my property.

In exchange for being permitted to participate in these activities for myself, my heirs, guardian, and legal representatives, I release and agree not to make or bring any claim of any kind against Lakeside Arena, US Mounted Games Association, or its masters, officers, directors, members, employees, or guests or any landowners, landholders or the persons making property available for the activity (including death), to me or any damage to my property whether from anyone's negligence or not, or any other cause, arising out of my participation in these dangerous horseback riding or related activities; and I also agree if anyone makes any claims because of any injury to me (including death), or for any damage to my property, I will keep all those released by this agreement free of any damages or costs because of those claims.
