Please Review and sign below agreeing to USMGA Code of Conduct:

The United States Games Association's mission and purpose is to provide a friendly and safe environment for all our members. This purpose is consistent with the International Mounted Games code of conduct which requires members "to conduct themselves in a manner which reflects positively on the sport of Mounted Games, and at no time in a manner which is offensive." Offensive behavior includes but is not limited to:

- Shouting at officials or behaving disrespectfully
- Shouting or behaving disrespectfully toward other riders, teams or supporters
- Using inappropriate language or gestures
- Abuse of ponies
- Verbal, written or physical threats or insults
- Members will not institute or threaten to bring any lawsuit or legal action against USMGA or its officers, directors or referees.
- Infractions at a competition will be taken to the ground jury, who will deliberate as to whether or not an individual or team has violated the code of conduct. Depending on severity of the infraction, offenders may receive warnings, elimination from the competition or a ban from competitions for the remainder of the year. Inappropriate and or offensive behavior among members, supporters or officials that occur outside of competition shall be reported to the President of USMGA who will confer with members of the board as to what action will be taken up to and including expulsion from USMGA. I understand that I will be under the governance of IMGA rules and procedures and USMGA constitution, Bylaws and procedures. As stated in bylaws, membership may be denied or terminated at any time, with or without cause by board of directors.
